Clinical Year Time Estimates and Obligations

Per the CMHC Practicum and Internship Handbook, students have Practicumfæmthæitæfinship year in the CMHC program. The year is broken up into threePsantestens15 weeks (summer semester), Internship I, 15 weeks (fall semester) ship II, 15 weeks (spring semester). Within each of those semesters there is a minimum requirement of hours that the student must be at the Placement (either on site or virtual) either working with clients or doing indirect work for the site. I note, many sites require students to be in physicallycer virtually eekdays, during the day, and we as a program have no control over this.

In addition to the requirements or Practicum and Internship, the student has additional course each semester: MHC 7203 Counseling for Career Development, MHC 8092 Consultation for Counsel and MHC 8092 pervision for Counselors. As well students will be studying and taking the CPCE in late fall andemands of the graduate work, family, employment and friends to ensure completion of the Program and graduate.
