I. COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course uses a theoretical approach to crisis intervention in social, therapeutic, and business settings. GOAL A:

- B-2 Develop plans for institutional response to crisis including getting backup.
- B-3 Demonstrate ability to work effectively in a team.
- B-4 Explain the value of appropriate supervision in a crisis situation.
