Objective B: Student will be able to use flash photography

B-1. Use on camera flash

B-2. Use bounce flash

B-3. Use flash off the camera

Objective C: Student will effectively use lights on location.

C-1. Use light to photograph people outside at dusk

C-2. Use light with slow shutter speeds showing motion or blur in the final image

C-3. Set up multiple lights on light stands

C-4. Mix ambient light with flash for effect
